EXAMINE THE PACKAGE CONTENTS

Carefully examine the contents of this package. THE CONTENTS OF THE BOX

Make note of the existence of the following contents.

- 1. Right Side (quantity of one)
- 2. Left Side (quantity of one)
- 3. Hanging Rails (quantity of four)
- 4. Shouldered Connector Bolts (quantity of eight)
- 5. 2-1/2" Adhesive Backed Felt Furniture Pads (quantity of two)
- 6. 1-1/2" Adhesive Backed Felt Furniture Pads (quantity of two)
- 7. Hex Allen Wrench (quantity of one)

ASSEMBLY PROCEDURE

Review the figure on page three and identify the components listed above. Begin with Step 1 and follow the directions exactly. When you have finished assembling your quilt ladder, lean it against a wall in a prominent place in your home, and drape several quilts over the rails. Now stand back and enjoy!

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

Assemble four Hanging Rails to the Left Side with four (4) of the Shouldered Connector Bolts. Insure that the Hanging Rails are fitted inside the pockets on the Left Side. Securely tighten all four (4) of the shouldered connector bolts with the Hex Allen Wrench.

Step 2

Place the partially assembled ladder on its Left Side with the Hanging Rails pointing up. It is best to do this on a carpeted surface to keep from scratching the finish. It may also be helpful to enlist some help to hold this assembly for the next step.

Step 3

Position the Right Side onto the Hanging Rails capturing them in the pockets. It will help to partially thread a Shouldered Connector Bolt through each hole and into the Hanging Rail to keep things in place. Tighten all four (4) of the Shouldered Connector Bolts to hold the Quilt Ladder together.

Step 4

Remove the adhesive backing from the 2-1/2" Felt Furniture Pads and carefully attach them to the small slanted surface of the Left and Right Sides where they will rest against the wall. Center them as best as you can because once installed, they will be difficult to remove.

Step 5

Remove the adhesive backing from the 1-1/2" Felt Furniture Pads and carefully attach them to the bottom of the Left and Right Sides where they will rest against the floor, centering them as best as you can. This completes the assembly of your Quilt Ladder.

Setting Up Your Quilt Ladder


The desired angle of slope for the Quilt Ladder is 10 degrees when properly positioned against the wall and the floor. You can insure this angle, by inspecting the surfaces of the Left and Right Sides where they meet the wall. Upon inspection, there should not be any gap between the Felt Furniture Pads and the wall. Make adjustments as necessary for this to be the case.

If you are resting the Quilt Ladder on a hardwood or tiled surface, it is important to keep the Quilt Ladder at the required 10 degrees of slant. Otherwise, when weighted down with quilts, it may slide along the floor and fall to the ground.

Cautionary Note:

As a point of caution, even though our Quilt Ladders are substantially made and look strong enough to hold a lot of weight, they are not intended to be used by anyone as a ladder.
